

What personally identifiable data is being stored?

The Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission (OHRC) collects personally identifiable data as required for agency programs and for certain permits, registrations, licensures and certifications.

How is the personally identifiable data stored?

Personally identifiable data is stored in a variety of ways including electronic and paper form. OHRC protects all personal information in accordance with State of Oklahoma Information Security policies, procedures, guidelines (as applicable) found at:

With whom does OHRC share this information?
