A. MINUTES

The drafted Minutes of the January 21st, 2021 Regularly Scheduled Commission Meeting will be considered for approval.

THE FOLLOWING MATTERS ARE PRESENTED FOR CONSIDERATION AND ACTION, IF ANY, DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE COMMISSION.

B. <u>CONTINUED DELIBERATIONS REGARDING THE APPEAL OF CRISTINO ESTRADA-REGALADO, OWNER/TRAINER REGARDING STEWARDS ORDERS 20-FMT-26B, 20-FMT-27B, AND 20-FMT-28B.</u>

Background

At the January 21st, 2021 meeting, the Commission took preliminary action to affirm Steward's Orders 20-FMT-26B, 20-FMT-27B, AND 20-FMT-28B and asked for legal counsel to prepare a final order for consideration at a future meeting for the following reasons:

- For the presence of Clenbuterol, a prohibited substance, in horse "JESS CUZ IM PERFECT" following the race held at Fair Meadows on June 20, 2020.
- For the presence of Clenbuterol, a prohibited substance, and the presence of permitted substances Flunixin at level of 31.0 +/-3.3ng/ml and Dexamethasone at a level 85.4 +/-0.6 pg/ml, exceeding Commission threshold levels, in the horse "DTL HES MAN CANDY", following the race held at Fair Meadows Tulsa on June 26th, 2020, and
- For the presence of Clenbuterol, a prohibited substance, in the horse "DTL CORONADO PLAYBOY", following the race held at Fair meadows Tulsa on June 27th, 2020.

Possible Executive Session:

Pursuant to 25 O.S. § 307 (B)(8) and 311 (B)(1), an Executive Session may be proposed for the purpose of deliberations in an individual proceeding regarding Mr. Estrada-Regalado.

Possible Action:

Possible action may include, but is not limited to: take no action; adopting the Final Order as proposed, adopting the Final Order as modified, or continue the matter.

C. <u>PETITION FOR APPEAL OF MARCOS CARRIZALES, TRAINER</u> REGARDING STEWARDS' ORDER 20-RP-23A.

<u>Background</u>

On November 30, 2020, the Commission received a Petition for Appeal for Order 20-RP-023A issued by the Board of Stewards at Remington Park, dated November 23, 2020.

The Board of Stewards found Mr. Carrizales to be in violation of OAC 325:45-1-4 <u>Substance Violations</u>; and OAC 325:45-1-11 <u>Trainer Responsibility</u>, for the presence of Clenbuterol, a prohibited substance, in the horse "MR JESS JENKINS", following the race held at Remington Park on April 5, 2020.

The Board of Stewards fined Mr. Carrizales ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) and suspended his Owner/Trainer license for three hundred sixty five (365) days. The suspension runs from Tuesday, November 24, 2020 through Monday November 22, 2021.

The Stewards further ordered that the Quarter Horse "MR JESS JENKINS" be disqualified from First (1st) Place and shall remain unplaced in the Fourth (4th) Race at Remington Park on Sunday, April 5, 2020.

Current Consideration

The Hearing before the Commission will be conducted pursuant to the authority and jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, Title 75 O.S., § 301 *et seq*; the Oklahoma Horse Racing Act, Title 3A O.S. § 200 *et seq.*; the OHRC Rules of Racing, OAC 325, and OAC 325:7-1-24 Appeal Hearing Procedures.

The procedure for the Appeal Hearing before the Commission is as follows:

- 1. The Commission will hear oral argument on whether to accept or deny the "Aid to Commissioners of the Honorable Horse Racing Commission" document submitted by the Appellant on February 12, 2021.
- 2. The Commission will hear oral argument on the Petition for Appeal. The parties' presentations are limited to arguments based on information in the record of the Board of Stewards hearing. The Commission may consider new evidence not in the record, provided that the proponent makes an offer of proof briefly explaining the new evidence, including an explanation of how the evidence satisfies the requirements set forth in OAC 70-1-22(2).
- 3. The Appellant, Mr. Marcos Carrizales, or his counsel will present oral arguments first, with the Board of Stewards or their counsel proceeding next. Each party will be allowed fifteen (15) minutes to present its case.
- 4. All parties are subject to questioning by the Commissioners, Commission Staff, and Commission Counsel.

Possible Executive Session

Pursuant to 25 O.S. § 307 (B)(8) and 311 (B)(1), an Executive Session may be proposed for the purpose of deliberations in an individual proceeding regarding Mr. Carrizales. An executive session may be proposed following oral argument for any Preliminary Motions and the Petition for Appeal.

- 1. Motion and Vote to Go Into Executive Session for the Purpose Stated Above
- 2. Motion and Vote to Reconvene in Open Session

Possible Action:

Possible action may include, but is not limited to: take no action; take preliminary action on the matter(s) and instruct the Commission Legal Advisor to draft Order(s) for consideration in further deliberations at a future Commission Meeting: or continue the matter(s).

D. CONSIDERATION OF THE REQUEST FROM WILL ROGERS DOWNS TO RELEASE EARNED INTEREST FROM ESCROW ACCOUNT.

Background

On March 2nd, 2021, the Executive Director, Mr. Cathey, received a request from Will Rogers Downs requesting the distribution of the interest earned on the funds required to be held in escrow. Pursuant to the terms of the Escrow Agreement, distribution of funds from the account requires approval of the Commission.
