Background

On January 24,2022, the Commission received a Petition for Appeal for Order 21-RP-038B filed on behalf of Kelly Marlene Heltzel. On June 16,2022, the matter was continued and set for hearing on November 17, 2022. At the November 17, 2022, meeting the commission voted to affirm the Steward's Order.

E. <u>PETITION FOR APPEAL FILED ON BEHALF OF GARY WALKER</u> (OWNER/TRAINER) ORDER 22-WRD-072.

Background

The OHRC received a petition for appeal on November 30,2022, for OHRC licensee Gary Walker on behalf of himself for order 22-WRD-72 issued by the board of Stewards at Will Rogers Downs, dated November 21,2022.

The Board of Stewards found Mr. Walker to be in violation of OAC 325:15-5-7

<u>Knowledge of Rules</u>; OAC 325:35-1-5 <u>Trainer Responsibility</u>; OAC 325:35-1-16

<u>Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing</u>; OAC 325:35-1-23 <u>Compliance with Orders of Racing Officials and Commission</u>

The Board of Stewards fined Mr. Walker the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

Current Consideration

The Hearing before the Commission will be conducted pursuant to the authority and jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, Title 75, § 301 etseq., the Oklahoma Horse Racing Act, Title 3A O.S. § 200 et seq., and O.A.C. 325(OHRC Rules of Racing), Chapter 70, Objections and Protests: Hearings and Appeals.

The procedure for the consideration of the Petition for Appeal is set as follows:

- 1. The appellant, Mr. Walker, and the Board of Stewards at Will Rogers Downs are entitled to be present and to present arguments.
- 2. The appellant, Mr. Walker, or his counsel will present oral arguments first, with Counsel for the Board of Stewards proceeding next. Each party willbe allowed fifteen (15) minutes in total oral argument, including any

rebuttal argument.

- 3. The Appeal is not a new evidentiary hearing on the matter. Both parties are limited to making arguments/comments concerning the evidence presented at the Board of Stewards' Hearing. However, the Commission may consider new evidence not found in the record of the Board of Stewards' Hearing, provided that the proponent makes an offer of proof briefly explaining the new evidence, including an explanation of how the evidence satisfies the requirements set forth in OAC 70-1-22(2).
- 4. All parties are subject to questioning by the Commissioners, Commission Staff and Commission Counsel.

Possible Executive Session

Pursuant to 25 O.S. § 307 (B)(8) and 311 (B)(1), an Executive Session may be proposed for the purpose of deliberations in an individual proceeding regarding Mr. Walker. An executive session may be proposed following oral argument for each Preliminary Motion and the Petition for Appeal.
