C. <u>POSSIBLE FINAL ACTION ON PROPOSED RULE AMENDMENTS TO 8</u> <u>CHAPTERS IN RULES OF RACING UNDER PERMANENT RULEMAKING</u>

Background

At the August 22, 2019 meeting, the Commission approved the permanent rulemaking process to consider proposed amendments to the following chapters in *Rules of Racing:*

- Chapter 15, Licensing
- Chapter 25, Entries and Declarations
- Chapter 35, General Conduct
- Chapter 45, Prohibited Practices and Equine Testing
- Chapter 50, Human Substance Abuse Testing
- Chapter 60, Running the Race
- Chapter 70, Objections and Protests; Hearing and Appeals
- Chapter 75, Oklahoma-Bred Program

Mr. Kelly Cathey, Commission Executive Director, will present the public comments. Following the Public Hearing, proposed revisions were made to Rules 325:25-1-19 Deadline for arrival of entered horses and 325:50-1-2 Definitions.

The Ad Hoc Committee on Rules unanimously supports all proposed rule amendments.

Current Consideration

The next step in the rulemaking process is the Commission's consideration of adopting the proposed rule amendments in the chapters under the permanent rulemaking process.

Background

Furthermore the Commission directed its legal advisor to prepare a proposed Final Order with Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law for continued deliberations at the February 20, 2020 Commission Meeting.

E. <u>CONTINUED DELIBERATIONS FOR JOSE VILLAFRANCO-VAZQUEZ,</u> <u>OWNER/TRAINER, REGARDING THE APPEAL OF STEWARDS'</u> <u>ORDER 19-RP-072</u>.

At the January 16, 2020 meeting, the Commission took preliminary action to affirm Stewards Order 19-RP-072, including the fines, suspension, and disqualifications of both horses. Furthermore the Commission directed its legal advisor to prepare a proposed Final Order with Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law for continued deliberations at the February 20, 2020 Commission Meeting.

F. <u>APPEAL HEARING FOR FRANCISCO J. BRAVO,</u> <u>OWNER/TRAINER, REGARDING STEWARDS' ORDER 19-WRD-</u> 069

Background

The matter was continued from the January 16, 2020 Commission Meeting.

In Stewards' Order 19-WRD-069, the Board of Stewards at Will Rogers Downs found Mr. Bravo to be in violation of Commission rules when his thoroughbred horse "EASE IT ON OVER" tested positive for an overage of Xylazine, following a race at Will Rogers Downs on April 3, 2019.

The Board of Stewards at Will Rogers Downs found that Francisco J. Bravo, having a second offense for a Category "B" substance in the past 365 days, shall be and is hereby fined one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) and is suspended and/or made ineligible for licensure for a period of thirty (30) days, effective the first day of Live Racing of the 2020 Will Rogers Downs Spring Meet.

Current Consideration

The Hearing before the Commission will be conducted pursuant to the authority and jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, Title 75, § 301 et seq., the Oklahoma Horse Racing Act, Title 3A O.S. § 200 et seq., OAC 325 (OHRC *Rules of Racing*), OAC 325:70-1-22, Grounds for Appeal from Decision of the Stewards, and OAC 325:70-1-24, Appeal Hearing Procedure.

The procedure for the Hearing before the Commission is set as follows:

- 1. The appellant, Mr. Bravo, and the Board of Stewards at Will Rogers Downs are entitled to be present and to present arguments.
- 2. The appellant, Mr. Bravo, or his counsel will present oral arguments first, with the Board of Stewards or their counsel proceeding next. Each party will be allowed fifteen (15) minutes to present its case.
- 3. The Appeal is not a new evidentiary hearing on the matter. Both parties are limited to making arguments/comments concerning the evidence presented at the Board of Stewards' Hearing. However, the Commission may consider new evidence not found in the record of the Board of Stewards' Hearing, provided that the proponent makes an offer of proof briefly explaining the new evidence, including an explanation of how the evidence satisfies the requirements set forth in OAC 70-1-22(2).
- 4. All parties are subject to questioning by Commissioners, Commission Staff and Commission Counsel.

G. <u>APPEAL HEARING FOR MIGUEL PENA-RODRIGUEZ,</u> <u>OWNER/TRAINER, REGARDING STEWARDS' ORDER 19-RP-</u> <u>027B</u>

Background

In Stewards' Order 19-RP-027B, the Board of Stewards at Remington Park found Mr. Pena-Rodriguez to be in violation of OAC 325:35-1-31 <u>Fighting</u> for the assault of David Eurique Bieblas at Remington Park on April 9, 2019.

It was the Order of the Board of Stewards at Remington Park that the Owner/Trainer license issued to Miguel Pena-Rodriguez shall be suspended for thirty (30) days beginning Friday, April 12, 2019 and continuing through May 11, 2019.

Current Consideration

The Hearing before the Commission will be conducted pursuant to the authority and jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, Title 75, § 301 et seq., the Oklahoma Horse Racing Act, Title 3A O.S. § 200 et seq., OAC 325 (OHRC *Rules of Racing*), OAC 325:70-1-22, Grounds for Appeal from Decision of the Stewards, and OAC 325:70-1-24, Appeal Hearing Procedure.

The procedure for the Hearing before the Commission is set as follows:

- 1. The appellant, Mr. Miguel Pena-Rodriguez, and the Board of Stewards at Remington Park are entitled to be present and to present arguments.
- 2. The appellant, Mr. Miguel Pena-Rodriquez, or his counsel will present oral arguments first, with the Board of Stewards or their counsel proceeding next. Each party will be allowed fifteen (15) minutes to present its case.
- 3. The Appeal is not a new evidentiary hearing on the matter. Both parties are limited to making arguments/comments concerning the evidence presented at the Board of Stewards' Hearing. However, the Commission may consider new evidence not found in the record of the Board of Stewards' Hearing, provided that the proponent makes an offer of proof briefly explaining the new evidence, including an explanation of how the evidence satisfies the requirements set forth in OAC 70-1-22(2).
- 4. All parties are subject to questioning by Commissioners, Commission Staff and Commission Counsel.
