# D. <u>CONTINUED CONSIDERATION OF AMENDMENTS TO</u> <u>DIRECTIVE 85-D-1 REV. 07/24/03 RELATING TO CRIMINAL</u> HISTORY LICENSING

This matter is continued from the August 25,2022 Commission meeting to allow

updates to draft to ensure alignment with the new law.

OHRC Directive 85-D-1, Rev. 07/24/03 provides direction for issuing licenses to applicants with certain criminal histories. Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1691, effective November 1, 2022, amends state law requirements and restrictions for denying licenses to applicants with criminal histories. The Commission will consider amendments to Directive 85-D-1 to incorporate the changes to state law. If amended by the Commission, Directive 85-D-1 will take effect on November 1, 2022.

#### **Possible Action:**

Possible action may include but is not limited to: taking no action, taking preliminary action to approve the Directive 85-D-1 relating to Senate Bill No. 1691, or continuing the matter.
