- Chapter 80, Gaming Licensing Requirements

- Chapter 85, Gaming Machine Specifications and Use and Operation Requirements
- Chapter 90, Gaming Operations

Mr. Kelly Cathey, Commission Executive Director, will present the public comments. Following the Public Hearing, proposed revisions were made.

The Ad Hoc Committee on Rules unanimously supports all proposed rule amendments.
