Call to Order

D. PETITION FOR APPEAL FILED ON BEHALF OF JUAN PULIDO (JOCKEY).

Chairman Lucas advised the Commissioners on the appeal of steward's order 21-RP-057 September 8, 2021, by which Jockey Juan Pulido was suspended from race riding for 14 days. And Ms. Sandra Balzer advised the Commissioners that an email from Mr. Pulido's attorney (John Mac Hayes), was received shortly before the meeting, in which Mr. Hayes stated, "I will not resist your motion to dismiss".

Vice Chair Keener made the motion to dismiss the appeal of Juan Pulido based on the fact that it was filed untimely, and in light of legal counsel for Mr. Pulido stating in the above-mentioned email that he would not resist the motion to dismiss. Secretary Sanders seconded the motion, and the vote was as follows:


Chairman Lucas adjourned the meeting at 9:39 a.m.
