SUMMARY:

The proposed rule amendments modify definitions to conform and update language and standards of measurement; modify and clarify the permitted substances language; modify certain threshold limits for thoroughbreds, quarter horses, paints, and appaloosas; modify and clarify declaring the use of furosemide; strike current fines and penalties for violation of furosemide use while adopting standardize fines and penalties; strike current fines and penalties for violation of phenylbutazone use while adopting standardize fines and penalties; modify the substance classification and penalties to the current uniform version; modify the prohibited practice by adding an additional practice; modify the environmental contaminants disciplinary action regulatory threshold to the current version; and correct and update language.
