## TITLE 325. OKLAHOMA HORSE RACING COMMISSION

## **CHAPTER 35. GENERAL CONDUCT**

# 325:35-1-5. Trainer Responsibility

- (a) The Trainer is presumed to know the <u>FRulesof racing</u>. The Trainer and is responsible for the condition, soundness, and eligibility of the hHorses they train. s/he enters in a race. The Trainer shall conduct his/her their business of training race the hHorses with appropriate reasonable care and skill, and in a humane manner, and with due regard to the interests of his/her their Owners and to the safety of employees and Agents and of the hHorses in his/her their care.
- (b) Should the chemical analysis, urine or otherwise, taken from a hHorse under his/her their supervision show the presence of any substance except as otherwise provided for in Chapter 45, it shall be taken as prima facie evidence that it the same was administered by or with the knowledge of the Trainer or person or person under their his/her supervision-having care or custody of such horse.
- (c) <u>Under the provisions of this Section</u>, <u>tThe Trainer is also</u>-responsible for any puncture mark(s) on any <u>h</u>Horse <u>they s/he</u> enters in a <u>rRace.</u>, found by the Stewards upon recommendation of the Racing or Official Veterinarian to evidence injection by syringe.
- (d) If the Trainer cannot be present on <u>FRace dDays s/he they</u> shall designate an Assistant Trainer. Such designation shall be made prior to time of entry, unless otherwise approved by the Stewards. Failure to fully disclose the actual Trainer of a <u>hH</u>orse participating in an approved <u>rRace</u> shall be grounds to disqualify the <u>hHorse</u> and subject the actual Trainer to possible disciplinary action by the Stewards or the Commission. Designation of an Assistant Trainer shall not relieve the Trainer's absolute responsibility for the conditions and eligibility of the <u>hHorse</u>, but shall place the Assistant Trainer under such absolute responsibility also. Willful failure on the part of the Trainer to be present at, or refusal to allow the taking of any specimen, or any act or threat to prevent or otherwise interfere therewith shall be cause for disqualification of the <u>hHorse</u> involved; and the matter shall be referred to the Stewards for further action.
- (eb) In addition to the <u>foregoing</u> responsibilities of (a) of this Section, a Trainer has the following specific responsibilities:
  - (1) Knowledge of substance rules;
  - (2) Knowledge of substance status of all hHorses in their his/her care;
  - (3) Knowledge of Furosemide use rules;
  - (4) To register all horses in their his/her care with the Racing Secretary;
  - (5) To ensure that no injectable substances, hypodermic needles, syringes, or electrical or mechanical device (other than the ordinary whip or approved twitch) that which may or ean be used for the purpose of stimulating or depressing a hHorse or affecting its speed at any time are in their his/her possession; in the possession of employees; or in automobiles; or in trailers; or in sleeping, storage or stable areas owned by or assigned to that Trainer or Trainer's employees;
  - (6) Proper entering and eligibility of all helperses in their his/her care;
  - (7) Guard horses in their his/her care;
  - (8) Make any declaration or scratch of an entered hHorse in their his/her care;

- (9) Bill and account for fees and services rendered on behalf of any hHorse in their his/her-care to the appropriate Owner or Owner(s).
- (10) To instruct and determine the training regimen of all  $\frac{h}{H}$  orses in  $\frac{h}{h}$
- (<u>fe</u>)No Trainer duty or responsibility, whether listed in (a) or (b) of this Section or not, may be assigned to any <u>a</u> person who is ineligible to hold a license or who is under suspension in this or any other racing jurisdiction.
- (gd)No licensed Trainer shall assume any of the responsibilities described in this Section for a hHorse they do not train<del>not under his/her active care, supervision or custody</del>.
- (<u>he</u>)Trainers who are summarily suspended or suspended for more than sixty (60) days shall not be permitted to transfer their horses to <u>a</u> family <u>member</u>. A suspended trainer shall not provide financial assistance to, or have communication concerning care, custody, or control with a receiving <u>t</u>Trainer, <u>onceafter</u> a transfer has been completed.

## 325:35-1-13. Possession of Contraband

No person other than a Veterinarian licensed by the Commission shall have in <a href="theirhis/her">theirhis/her</a> possession within the enclosure any prohibited substance, any injectable substance, or any hypodermic syringe or hypodermic needle or similar instrument which may be used for injection. Nor shall any person have in his/her possession within the enclosure the substance Clenbuterol other than in a form approved by the FDA, which approval currently allows the use of Clenbuterol under two brand names, Ventipulmin Syrup and Aeropulmin Syrup. Possession within the enclosure of any form of Clenbuterol other than the Ventipulmin Syrup and Aeropulmin Syrup, in their original container, the container in which the substance was distributed by its manufacturer, is prohibited. No person shall have in <a href="theirhis/her-possession">their his/her-possession</a> within the enclosure any device which can be used for the purpose of stimulating or depressing the horse or affecting its speed at any time other than the ordinary whip or twitch approved by the Stewards. The Stewards may permit the possession of substance or appliances by a licensee for personal medical needs under such condition as the Stewards may impose.

## 325:35-1-21. Tricks/Schemes Prohibited

No person shall falsify, conceal, or cover up by any trick, scheme, or devicedevise a material fact; or make any false, fictitious, or fraudulent statements or representations; or make or use any false writing or document knowing the same to contain any false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or eEntry regarding the prior racing record, pedigree, identity, or ownership of a registered animal in any matter related to the breeding, buying, selling, training or racing of the animal. No person shall make false, fictitious, or fraudulent statements or misrepresent the identity of a hHorse or make or use any false writing, document, or statement to an eOrganization lLicensee, or to the Stewards, or to the Commission.
